Dates for Submission:

Guidelines:

- All entries must be typed and titled
- Poems should be no more then 24 lines including the title with a max of 24 letters/spaces per line.
- Include name, address, age, grade, and school of participant on the back of entry. Also include Garden Club of York and Garden Club Federation of PA
- All entries become the property of National Garden Clubs, Inc.
- Poems do not have to rhyme.
- Poems may be traditional verse, acrostics, blank verse, cinquains, diamond poems, limerick, or Haiku.
- The theme should not be used as the title to any poetry, but please be creative and incorporate the theme, I Spy with My Little Eye, Something Green Outside
