

The Garden Club of York Scholarship Application School Year 2026-27

High school seniors or college students who meet the following criteria may apply for a \$2000 scholarship through the Garden Club of York, located in York Pennsylvania.

- Major area of study must be one of the following: Biology (except pre-med), Horticulture, Floriculture, Landscape Architecture, Conservation, Forestry, Botany, Agronomy, Plant Pathology, Land Management, Wildlife Sciences, Environmental Science, Rural/Urban Planning.
- Applicant must be a resident of York County, PA. They may be either high school seniors or college students who are enrolled in a bachelor's degree program at a 4-year college or university.
- Applicant must maintain high academic standing and have apparent need.

The following items must be included to complete the application process:

- Official academic transcript sent from student's high school. Note: if student has previously won our scholarship, the high school transcript is not necessary.
- If applicant is currently attending college, the most recent college transcript must also be included.
- Completed and signed financial need form. It is not necessary to use our form, but please make sure all requested information is included, so that we can get a true picture of your financial need, and that the form is signed by financial officer.
- A typed essay written by the applicant, signed and dated. Essay must be written within in the last year. It should address all the following key points:
 1. **Personal commitment to your course of study:** Explain how you became interested in your chosen field of study and what motivates you to pursue it.
 2. **Honors and achievements:** Highlight awards, recognitions, or accomplishments related to your field or to your interests outside of your field of study.
 3. **Special interests:** Share any personal interests or experiences that have influenced your life and/or academic or career path.
 4. **Goals:** Outline your short-term and long-term goals, both academically and professionally.
 5. **Financial need:** Briefly explain your financial need and how the scholarship will support your education.
 6. **Career aspirations:** Discuss your ultimate career goal and how this scholarship will help you achieve it.

- Three reference letters as listed on the application. Reference letters must be current. Students who are previous winners may not reuse the same letters. High school seniors and college freshmen should include a letter from a high school teacher or advisor. Older college students should include a letter from a college professor or advisor.
- At least one digital photograph of the applicant, casual and/or formal. If possible, include a head shot. These will be used for publicity purposes related to our scholarship program.
